Additional tags will be available on the day for parents to share their own wish and then be tied alongside their child's. Boxes will be out for donations.


Starting Primary School September 2020

Teacher Training Days

The remaining Teacher Training Day for this academic year is:

Analysis of attendance figures showed that taking this extended holiday in October 2019 reduced the percentage of holiday taken in term time around this period by a third. With this in mind I have decided to repeat this for the academic year 2020/21.

School will be closed to children from Monday 19th October 2020 for two weeks; children will return to school on Monday 2nd November 2020.

Three Teacher Training Days will be allocated, making the holiday period a full 2 weeks.

Family Holidays in Term Time

Schools have a very full curriculum to follow within the term time given and any absence has a negative effect on a child's learning. Whilst we acknowledge that illness cannot be helped, holidays should be taken during school closure periods. Following Government expectations on attendance, no leave of absence/holiday will be authorised for any child, irrespective of their attendance, except for exceptional circumstances.

Any request for leave must be made in writing, addressed to the Headteacher. A response will be returned indicating whether leave is authorised. Any absence not authorised may be liable to a local authority penalty notice.

Considerate Parking

The school car park is for staff and agreed visitors only. Please can I remind parents not to park or to drive in, even if the school gates are open, when arriving to drop off or collect your child. This should also be observed for Breakfast Club and after school clubs.

We encourage families to park in Morrisons car park wherever possible and politely request that when parking in surrounding roads to do so with consideration for the children, other adults and the local community. Please obey the restrictions in place and do not park in an obstructive manner.

The safety of the children is our priority.
